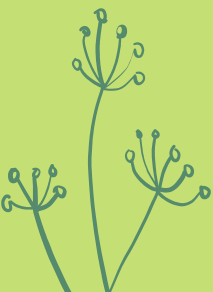

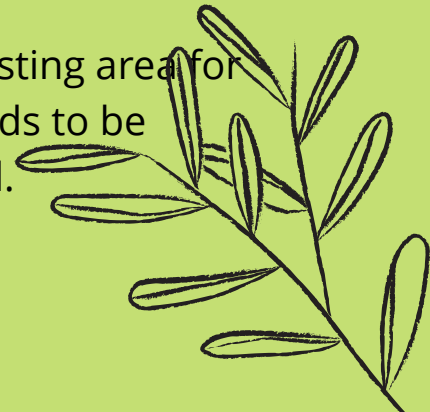


# Introduction

With its 128 km<sup>2</sup>, it ranks first in size among the lake basins of the Italian peninsula and fourth nationally.

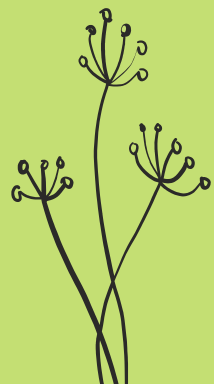
It is an indispensable resting area for migratory birds that needs to be protected and enhanced.

# Spiagge e fondali puliti

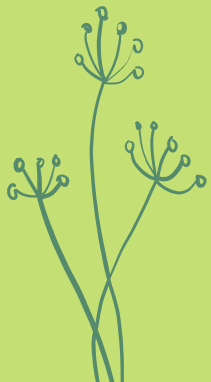

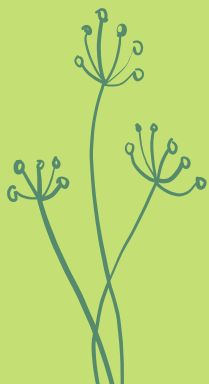
